Title: Everything you need to create an effective task analysis.

Presenters: Elizabeth C. Nulty, MS, BCBA & Adrianna Zambrzycka, LCSW, both from The Institute of Professional Practice

Skill Level: Beginner Basics – should have beginner knowledge of ABA

Course Description: Participants will learn to create effective task analyses through class lecture, demonstrations, and role-plays. Participants will create their own task analysis in class using the information presented in class.

Course Objectives: Participants will leave this workshop with the following abilities: ability to write operational definitions, as well as goals and objectives for skills taught using a task analysis; ability to create a task analysis through assessment; ability to appropriate training skills taught with a task analysis by using various chaining procedures; ability to collect and analysis data for task analyses.

Title: Motivating parents, teachers and staff to implement behavior plans.

Presenters: Elizabeth C. Nulty, MS, BCBA & Adrianna Zambrzycka, LCSW, both from The Institute of Professional Practice

Skill Level: Open to anyone wanting to improve their communication skills

Course Description: Participants will learn effective communication skills for working with parents, teachers and staff through class lecture, demonstrations, and role-plays. Participants will create a plan for effective communication using the information presented in class.

Course Objectives: Participants will leave this workshop with the following abilities: ability to identify problems in the follow-through of behavior plans; ability to strategically confront parties on follow-through problems; ability to effectively negotiate with disagreeing parties; ability to effectively influence others to follow behavior plans.

Presenter Information:

Elizabeth C. Nulty, MS, BCBA: Elizabeth Nulty has been working with children and families within Applied Behavior Analysis since 2002. She graduated with a master's degree in Behavior Analysis and Therapy from Southern Illinois University in 2004 and became a BCBA that same year. Elizabeth also earned a bachelor's of science degree in psychology from Arkansas State University in 2002. She has been working in the Professional Parenting Program (PPP) at The Institute of Professional Practice since 2004. PPP serves child in Connecticut with developmental and emotional disabilities who require therapeutic foster care.

Adrianna Zambrzycka, LCSW: Adrianna Zambrzycka has been working with Children and Families since 2000. She graduated with a master's degree in Social Work from University of Connecticut in 2004. Within a year Adrianna went back to school and completed an online 5 course sequence in Applied Behavior Analysis through University of North Texas. Adrianna earned her bachelor's of science degree in psychology from Central Connecticut State University in 2001. She has been working in the Professional Parenting Program at The Institute of Professional Practice since 2004. PPP is a private nonprofit organization serving children with developmental and emotional disabilities, who require professional level

foster care. Adrianna started at PPP as a social worker, upon completion of coursework thru UNT in 2006 she accepted a position as a behavior analyst.
