- Provide and receive professional feedback
- Communicate questions, concerns, and suggestions to Founding Directors

- Maintain safety, dignity, and confidentiality for all learners
- Ensures daily needs of learners (eating, toileting, etc) are met
- Contributes to overall cleanliness and organization of work space
